<p>Autumn 1 Our World Ein byd</p>	<p>Recycling/Adaptation and interdependence. Short writing from around the world/Poetry - animals. Finding out about current events around the world. Landscapes in Art. 'Carnival of the animals.' Citizenship and the global community. Christian values. Hockey and Dance.</p>
<p>Autumn 2 Move! Symud</p>	<p>Forces. People in Action. Moving Toys. Musical rhythms. Keeping Healthy. The Christmas Story. Gymnastics, basketball and dance.</p>
<p>Spring 1 Wales Cymru</p>	<p>'The Snow Spider' by Jenny Nimmo. Art/DT - Images to show Wales. Snowdon. Singing in Welsh/composing linked to Art. Life in Bible Times/Judaism. Feelings and relationships. Dance/outdoor education.</p>
<p>Spring 2/ Summer 1 World War 2 Ail rhyfel byd</p>	<p>World War Two - focus on children and Wales. Songs from W.W. 2 and composing music based on 'The Blitz.' Constructing shelters and sewing a toy for an evacuee. Easter/The life of St. Paul. Sound. Dance/outdoor education.</p>
<p>Summer 2 St. Lucia</p>	<p>St Lucia as a location. Creating headwear. Recognising songs/ composing in the style of the music of St Lucia. Life cycles. Transmission of the Bible/Islam. Gymnastics/badminton/rounders/athletics.</p>
