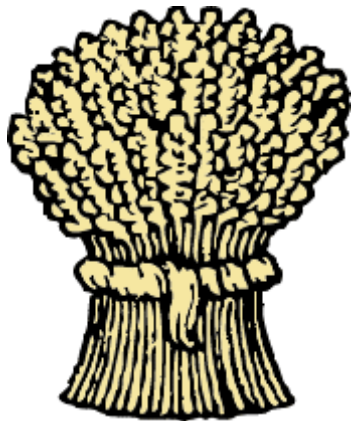

Send Love in a Box This Christmas

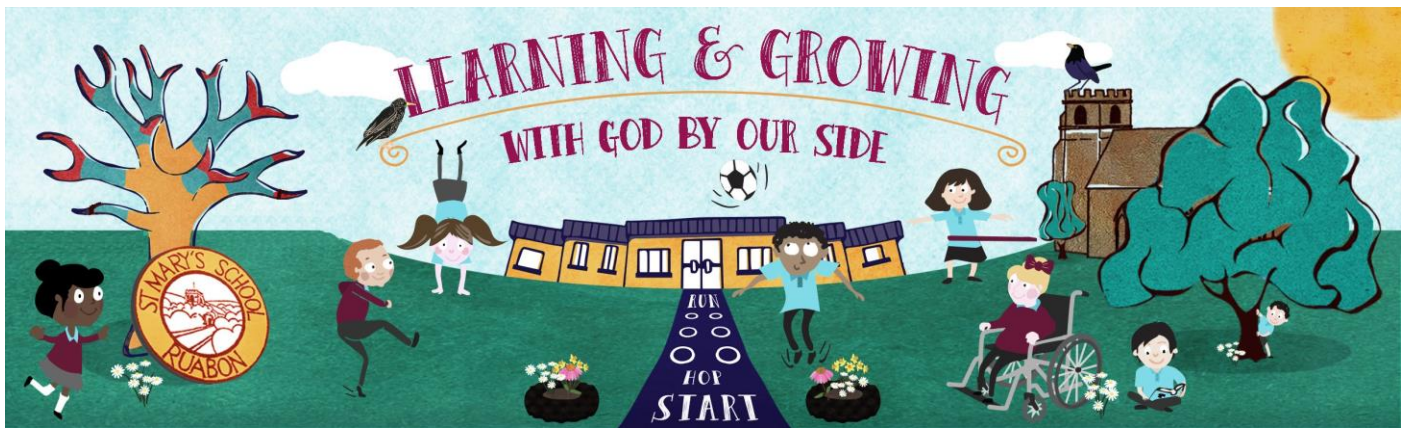
