Moving Forward

You will be aware that education budgets have been subject to cuts this year and, whilst in St Mary's we have been able to avoid redundancies and redeployment, we have not replaced staff who have retired or who were on short term contracts. All of this results in extra pressures on our current staff, which you might not necessarily see, but please bear this in mind and be patient when communicating with school. It would also help us greatly if children can come to school on time with everything that they need for the day. As a result of these cuts, our Governors, when planning the budget have had to make some changes going forward:

Swimming - moving forward swimming will be for one term only for Year 4 pupils in the summer term. Any parents who have over-paid for previous lessons will receive a refund after half term.

Trips - in previous years the school has heavily subsided school trips. Whilst school trips remain a voluntary contribution if we receive insufficient funds we will need to cancel trips for all those involved. Obviously, this is not something we want to do, but understand we are in a climate where everyone is watching their pennies. We will try to give you as much notice as possible if teachers intend to book a trip.

Residentials - from this year, there will be no residential trip for Year 5. Pupils will have the opportunity to go to Glan Llyn in Year 6 from next academic year.

I am sure you will agree, in times of austerity, keeping our staff in school is paramount to help the children's learning journey.

Secondary School Applications


